SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION/CONFESSIONS

We have cleared the space in the secondary porch at the back of Church to be available for Confessions. We have had a screen made to ensure anonymity and also as a protective measure against Covid 19. The chair will be sprayed with an anti – bacterial spray after each penitent or you may wish to stand and the outside door into the courtyard will remain open for ventilation. This will all ensure that the Sacrament can be celebrated with reverence and dignity whilst adhering to the necessary safety measures. A priest will be available after the midday Mass each day Monday to Friday and after the 10am Mass on a Saturday morning for Confessions.



The new Cathedral Choir, with Cathedral organist David Allison, sang at a Diocesan Mass to mark that occasion on Saturday, September 30, 2000.
